nbn™ network construction has begun in Tumby Bay

The **nbn™** network is Australia's new fast and reliable landline phone and internet network. It's designed to connect Australians to each other, and connect Australia to the world.¹

Construction of the **nbn™** network has started in parts of Tumby Bay to connect more than 1,200 premises to the **nbn™** fixed line network from September 2017.

As our **nbn™** construction partners move progressively through Tumby Bay, works in your area may involve:

- Installing cable through existing underground pipes or on existing overhead power poles.
- Digging and/or drilling on public property such as under footpaths or on nature strips.
- Installing pits, similar to the telecommunications pits you may already see in your area and new **nbn** cabinets and equipment.

The **nbn™** network is so much more than fast internet. It's a state of the art communications network, which opens up a world of possibilities across areas such as education, business and entertainment, and gives you the opportunity to be more productive, more creative, more efficient and more connected for decades to come.

Homes and businesses in the District Council of Tumby Bay

If your home or business is in Port Neill, you may now be able to connect to the **nbn™** network via fixed wireless technology. You can check whether you can connect to the **nbn™** network at www.nbn.com.au/check.

The **nbn™** fixed wireless network uses advanced technology, commonly referred to as LTE or 4G, and provides wholesale speeds of up to 50Mbps download and up to 20Mbps upload.² It's engineered to deliver services to a fixed number of premises within each coverage area. This means that the bandwidth per household is designed to be more consistent than mobile wireless, even in peak times of use.

All other homes and businesses in the District Council of Tumby Bay can connect to the **nbn™** network now via the Sky Muster™ satellite service. This involves a satellite dish being installed on your premises to receive the network signal from the Sky Muster™ satellite.

Designed to deliver a revolution in satellite broadband, the Sky Muster™ service is intended to be a game changer for the way you work, learn and live in regional and remote Australia. Eligible homes and businesses in the District Council of Tumby Bay can order a service today through one of ten satellite internet service providers.
