Burning within the township of TUMBY BAY, PORT NEILL, LIPSON and UNGARRA

Commencing 1st September 2019 – excludes Fire Danger Season

Conducting burning activities in the open other than in accordance with Council Policy 6.03 is an offence to which a maximum penalty of \$4,000 and expiation fee of \$300 applies.

Council has adopted Policy 6.03 to allow for the burning of vegetation within township areas outside of the fire danger season with the following conditions:

- Vegetation must have originated from the property on which it is being burnt
- No vegetation burning shall take place on a SUNDAY or PUBLIC HOLIDAY
- Vegetation Burning activity may only take place between 12.00 noon and 6.00pm
- Stockpiles of vegetation shall NOT be larger than 2m x2m x 1m high with a clearance of at least 4m.
- All other materials other than dry and matured vegetation are PROHIBITED from being burnt at any time
- PROHIBITED Materials include cardboard, paper, general waste, green garden waste, plastic, tyres and treated timber are PROHIBITED from being burnt at any time
- **IF IT DIDN'T GROW ON THE PROPERTY IT CAN NOT BE BURNT ON THE PROPERTY**
